DAY 1.

TRANSFER TO TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK AND TREK TO SERÓN CAMPSITE

Before your adventure begins, you will receive an email with technical information to help you prepare in the best possible way for your trip to Torres del Paine. Our team will coordinate the delivery of your welcome kit and vouchers. On the day your program starts, you will take the bus at 07:00 am from Puerto Natales. The journey takes approximately 2.5 hours.





Once you arrive, you will hike through the Encantado Valley and an old-growth native lenga forest on your way to Serón. If you look closely at the trees, you will notice they are covered with a special lichen known as "old man's beard", which only grows in the purest environments. As you listen to birdsong, you will already begin to enjoy unique views of the Paine Massif.

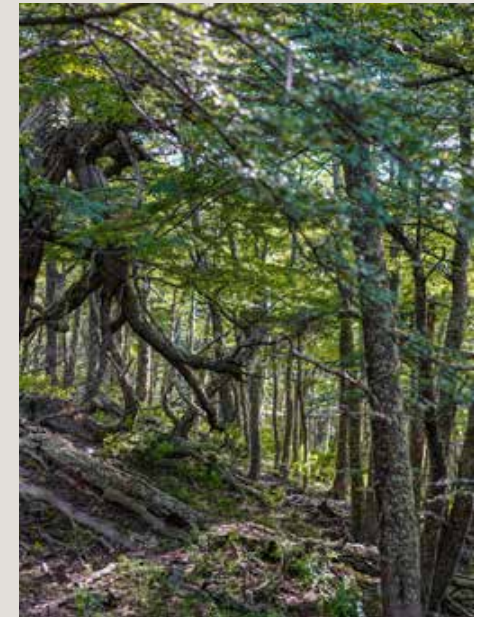

DAY 2

TREK TO DICKSON SECTOR

This long but unforgettable day will take you up and down the slopes of the Paine Massif. Everything you encounter along the way is so beautiful that the journey feels easier. Nature has a special way of rewarding your effort, and just after the steepest ascent, when you look out over the valley, you may feel as if you are in a dream. The campsite feels almost surreal: tents and a mountain stays set in a wide green area beside a vast lake, at the foot of imposing mountains. Soft, rolling clouds add the final touch to a scene that seems almost too perfect to be real. You will feel re-energized as you descend toward the shores of Lake Paine. Depending on weather conditions, you may catch views of the northeast summit of the Paine Massif.

DAY 3.

TREK TO LOS PERROS SECTOR

With a shorter hiking day ahead, take advantage of your stunning surroundings. Wake up early and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere near the river as you take in the imposing mountains and drifting clouds that briefly reveal the snow-covered peaks.

As you absorb the scenery, say goodbye to the serene landscape and hanging glacier behind you—your next stage leads into a lenga forest. The trees will shelter you from the elements, and you will begin to notice the sounds of the forest, including the distinctive tapping of Magellanic woodpeckers. The final stretch surprises you with views of Los Perros Glacier, resting above a calm, gray lagoon.

DAY 4.

TREK TO GREY GLACIER

Today you will be reminded why hard work is worth the effort. Possibly the most challenging day of the journey, it is also one of the most spectacular. You will depart early from Los Perros campsite, weaving across marshy forest terrain before emerging above the treeline.

The upper half of the mountain is a steep, rocky, and often snowy ascent toward the winding John Garner Pass. Once at the top, you will be rewarded with sweeping views of the Southern Patagonian Ice Field, featuring countless jagged peaks and vividly colored glacier crevasses.

As if that weren't enough, the descent offers breathtaking views of Grey Glacier, a landscape that feels as if it belongs to another planet.

DAY 5.

TREK TO PAINE GRANDE SECTOR

At this stage of your adventure, the W Circuit officially begins, and you will start exploring some of the park's most iconic attractions. After several intense days, today's hike will feel more relaxed and enjoyable.

You will walk along mountain slopes and through forests of Antarctic beech (ñirre), coigüe, and notro trees. This shorter yet rewarding trek leaves a lasting impression thanks to the rich diversity of natural elements that awaken your senses. Take time to appreciate the dense forest and low-hanging branches, the presence of Magellanic woodpeckers, and the views of Paine Grande, the highest peak in the region (3,050 m / 10,007 ft), along with its hanging glaciers. Upon reaching the campsite, you can rest, enjoy the warmth of the sun on your face, or take a peaceful walk along the shores of the turquoise Lake Pehoé.

DAY 6.

TREK TO THE FRANCÉS VALLEY

Start your morning in the perfect way with a light yet magnificent trek to Campamento Italiano. Your mind and body will align with the present moment as you process all the experiences of the previous days. Surrounded by mountains, you will feel a deep sense of calm, while the sounds of the lake and the surrounding landscape vibrate with energy amid abundant and diverse vegetation.

You will pass a stunning waterfall where you can refill your bottle with pure, cold water. This entire experience is perfectly complemented by the incomparable views from the Francés Valley. At the viewpoint, you will be amazed by one of the most breathtaking panoramas of the entire circuit.

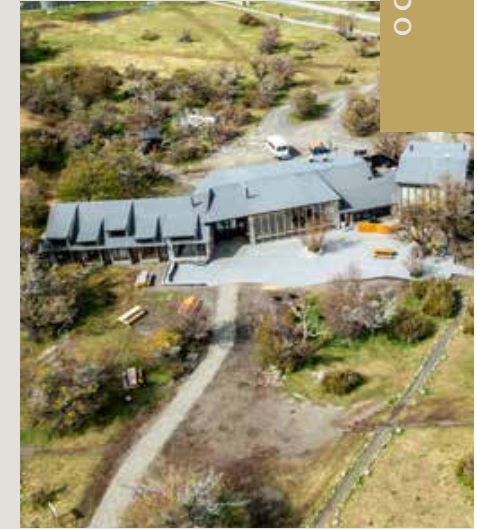

DAY 7.

TREK TO CENTRAL SECTOR

Walk along the peaceful shoreline of Lake Nordenskjöld, beneath the impressive Almirante Nieto Mountain and its hanging glaciers. The quiet atmosphere of the towering peaks above the turquoise lake invites you to slow your pace, absorb the magnitude of the landscape, and capture it forever in photographs.

The lake is full of geographic contrasts and is home to a wide variety of birdlife, so keep an eye out for the condors soaring overhead. You will continue along the Arriero River, enjoying several moments to rest, refill your water bottle, and savor the present moment. Upon reaching the highest viewpoint, you will be rewarded with sweeping views of the entire lake, and at the end of the day, you will also glimpse the Francés Glacier on Cerro Paine Grande. In the evening, you can celebrate your journey with a well-deserved beer after completing the trek.

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DAY 8.

TREK TO BASE TORRES – RETURN TO PUERTO NATALES

The day begins with an ascending walk across the Patagonian plains, which gradually becomes steeper as you enter the Ascencio Valley, climbing toward the Los Vientos Pass. Along the way, you will enjoy spectacular panoramic views of the surrounding landscapes and lakes. You will pass through the Chileno Sector and cross a native lenga forest before reaching the final stretch of the trek. This last section lasts approximately one hour over rocky terrain. At the end of the trail, you will be rewarded with the most iconic view of the park: the three granite towers rising above their glacial lagoon. You will then return along the same path to take the bus in the afternoon and head back to Puerto Natales, closing an unforgettable adventure.
